Title: Kingdom Inheritance

Passage: Matthew 25:31-46

Read Matt 25:31-46

Jesus speaks clearly about the final judgment and the separation of the sheep from the goats. He teaches the disciples that the care that is shown to those who are hungry, naked, strangers, reflects devotion to Jesus himself.

Blessing provoked us to consider how we practically express our faith through works, as James teaches (Read James 2:26).

He recalled a couple of personal stories of how God has been able to use his family to provide for, and bless others.

Suggested Questions:

1. What stood out to you from what Blessing shared?
2. As we head into the Christmas season, how can your faith be demonstrated by works to;
 - Your family
 - Neighbours/colleagues
 - The poor in Reading
 - Church family
3. As the Kingdom series concludes, what has stuck out to you? What are you taking away with you? How are you thinking differently?

(Reminder of some of the content; Seek first the Kingdom, Secrets of the Kingdom (parables), The prayer of the Kingdom, Kingdom Identity, Kingdom Humility, Mammon and the Kingdom)
