Elizabeth's Coronation

The coronation of Elizabeth II took place on 2 June 1953 at Westminster Abbey in London. She arrived at her coronation in the Gold State Coach and was processed to the altar. Here she was anointed with oil, and she swore an oath to uphold UK law and be the head of the Church of England. She was crowned Queen of a United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka. She was given crown jewels, of incalculable worth, symbolising power and wealth. She was then processed out and presented to her people, receiving the praise of her subjects. Her reign has endured for a record breaking 70 years. Her legacy will be one of steadfast service and duty over decades of tumultuous change.

Read Daniel 7v13-14

Son of Man's Coronation

In exile, Daniel has a vison of a heavenly coronation, long expected and hoped for by God's people. In this vision, Daniel someone like a 'son of man', a phrase that means this person is God, doubly confirmed becomes He's coming with the clouds of heaven. The son of man approaches the Ancient of Days, and is not destroyed by the Holiness of God, for he is a sinless man. This 'son of man' is given heaven's authority, honour, rule, power and sovereignty over all of creation. This is recognised by all the nations of the world, every race and nation and language would now obey him. His rule is eternal, all-encompassing and will never end. His kingdom will never be destroyed or usurped.
